WHAT DOES KOVITZ INVESTMENT GROUP PARTNERS, LLC (“KOVITZ”) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- account balances, assets, and transaction history
- investment experience, risk tolerance and account transactions

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Kovitz chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does Kovitz protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does Kovitz collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- open an account or give us your income information
- tell us about your portfolio or make deposits or withdrawals from your account
- enter into an investment advisory contract with us or provide account information
- Seek financial advice, show your government-issued ID or make a wire transfer

We also collect your personal information from other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Our affiliates include Focus Operating, LLC, Focus Treasury & Credit Solutions, LLC, Telemus Insurance Services, LLC, Origin Investments Group, LLC, Origin Credit Advisers, LLC, Institutional Family Asset Management, LLC, Relative Value Partners Group, LLC, and Dorchester Wealth Management Company.*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Kovitz does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *Kovitz does not jointly market.*
